ssociation for Craft Producers (ACP) is a not-for-profit Guaranteed Fair Trade organization providing a full cycle of services, including design, technical, management and marketing to low – income craft producers, primarily women. These services result in regular and adequate wages to supplement family income and improve the overall standard of living. ACP provides income generating opportunities to more than 800 handicraft producers (90% women) from 12 districts of Nepal in 17 skill categories and employs 38 full time staff. ACP deals with various product categories with a focus on

household cotton textiles, knitwear, felt, ceramics, copper, glass, silver jewelry, paper, leather, bamboo and woodworks in both the domestic and export markets. It caters to the local customers through its retail shop "Dhukuti" while the exporting is handled through its sister organization 'Nepali Craft Trading P. Ltd.'

ACP is also a member of World Fair Trade Organization (WFTO) – regional & global. ACP is accredited as guaranteed Fair Trade Organization by WFTO global. Nepali Craft Trading Private Limited is the sister concern of ACP and is also a Member Organization of Fair Trade Group Nepal.

Binu has been looking after all the finances of Krishna Arts, one of our ceramic production group, since more than 15 years. However, she always wanted to get involved as an artisan and work in the Ceramic production. For that reason, since past 2 years, she has been supervising and monitoring glazing and firing work in the workshop. With a concern due to higher damage in the production, she has started overseeing order and production plans and damage percentage. Her initiation for quality control in each step of the production has helped minimizing the damages.

She lives with her husband and both are involved in making ceramics. As an artisan, she got an opportunity to make new products and connect with different people: from the raw material collection to the finished product. Working with ACP has helped her in improving her financial status and upgrading her technical skills. Her communication skill has also enhanced and it motivates her to stay positive. Whenever there is less defective products post firing, she feels happy about it - and that is the favorite part of her work.



Ms. Burkert founded JWDC with a mission to empower women and help them get recognition as an artists across the world. JWDC. JWDC produces several products including Mithila paintings, canvas bags and stuffed animals.

The Janakpur Women's Development Center is a women's run NGO based in Kuwa village in southeastern Nepal. Its mission is to promote Mithila arts and empower Maithil women through the generation of income from their skills in making art and crafts. The Janakpur Women's Development Center was founded by an American called Claire Burkert in 1989. Ms. Burkert founded JWDC with a mission to empower women both economically and socially through income generation programs.

As a uniquely designed women's training and cultural centre, JWDC is the first of its kind to promote and preserve the ancient art and culture of Janakpur and a pioneer in introducing the art of Nepal's Maithili women to the national and international markets. The women come from neighboring villages to produce art and handicrafts as well as to receive training in various skills such as arts and business development.




AMRITA DUTTA

I had no special skills but I had learned to make kohbar (wedding chamber) paintings and aripan (ritual rice paste designs) and these helped me earn a living. I used to sell paintings at piece rate to different buyers. The situation at my house was so dire that I kept myself awake every night just to finish one painting. Still I could not cover the expenses of my seven family members. Things changed in 2011 when I joined the Janakpur Women's Development Center and my income as an artist became stable.

Anushi was founded in 1991 With the underlying mission of empowering marginalized women in Nepal to raise their social and economic status, Manushi started with a focus on providing women with handicraft skill development through workshops and training. However, due to common issues such as illiteracy and lack of income, it became clear that the women were unable to effectively utilize these skills to run and grow a business. In 1993, Manushi started its own production program to address this issue and provide women with opportunities to gain skills and employment. Tie and dye became the signature product and as Manushi learned to navigate the market. In time, Manushi's production program grew and became self-sustainable, allowing the organization to expand its scope of support to include a micro-credit program, the development and fostering of national and global partnerships, and other community-based programs for girls and women. Manushi Pvt. Ltd. and Manushi Arts and Craft Pvt. Ltd. is a sister concern of Manushi and is also a Member Organization of Fair Trade Group Nepal.


BABITA RAJBHANDARI

Coming from poor family background is a prime challenging social constraints for women in Nepal. But when you become single women, then the burden multiplies. Increased financial obligations and attached social stigmas (being a widow) makes very hard to accept the harsh realities of life. It's always a beyond imagination wish, for a single woman who makes small manual works with petty income, to be well articulated and make decisions at household. To participate at community level initiatives is more than the beyond cannot be fetched. To talk and listen about the issues of women's rights and empowerment and to experience and act up on the context of being subordinate in family

and in community is completely two different things. Being a women worker and to live a dignified life was a difficult task.

I joined SH sixteen years before in cutting unit. Now after years of my working relationship here, my life has changed and now I am proud to be a producer.

The key to challenge the woman sub-ordination, I think, is the need of women's work that pays good economic returns and that allows to participate. The income level I received from SH has made me empowered economically that I can make household expenses as per my will. My long walk with Sana Hastakala has made me a skilled producer, a good mother, and a bread winner of my family.

She is grateful to NLT for providing her and her husband with work. Maiti has faced many struggles in her life, and she says that "if it wasn't for NLT, she does not know where she would be and cannot imagine what her life would be like if she was not offered a job."



bitter experience, she kept weeping for many days as she couldn't afford this loss..

Three years ago Amrita became a member of Himchuli Agriculture Cooperative Jumla and Sinja Valley Group of Youth Entrepreneurs . Being a member of the cooperative/group she was greatly privileged; she has received a 7 day training about the know how on making improved farm yard manure and their application in the crop fields where chemical fertilizers and pesticides have been a no go area so far. The training course was convened by the above institutions on support of Krishi Gyan Kendra a Local Agriculture resource center Government of Nepal. She said the course also taught about the principles of organic farming as sustainable farming system for the Jumla farmers. During the training course she came to know that the Government of Nepal had declared Jumla district as organic district of Nepal.

MITHRAM & MENUKA SAPKOTA

A half hour walk uphill from the nearest road of Thuladurlung Lalitpur, this coffee farm has panoramic views of the surrounding hills and valleys, the southernmost point of Lalitpur district. Mitharam, a board member of the Durlung Jaibik Coffee Producer Cooperative, and his wife Menuka have been farming coffee here for 18 years. Coffee was a far superior crop

choice for them, because living near the jungle, most traditional crops are destroyed by wild animals. Since they live far from the road and market, it is more effort than it is worth to grow traditional crops, but coffee gets them a premium price that allows them to cover all of their household expenses and beyond. A few years back, Mithram fell ill but was able to cover the cost of his surgery and the hospital stay during his recovery, something that the family would not have been able to afford without their coffee income. Additionally, thanks to the income from coffee farming, the couple's one eldest daughter now live and go to the technical school in the another village to receive a better technical education than is available locally. Regardless of market uncertainty, they can be assured that the cooperative will pay them a fair price for their crop, and they will receive the payment on time with fair trade premium, which provides the family a valuable financial security. This family is able to save much time and effort because the cooperative takes the responsibility of processing their coffee, which results in a higher quality exportable green bean coffee than if they had to process it themselves. They are able to produce a much higher guality coffee in a large guantity which they are then able to sell to Coffee Cooperative Union Ltd. Lalitpur (CCUL), a member of Fair Trade Group Nepal (FTGN), CCUL sells coffee at a premium price on the international market to the fair trade buyer. The cooperative shows no discrimination based on gender, caste, religion, economic status etc. and they have seen major increases in this positive thinking and attitude towards one another in their community. "Unity is the force. To be a member of a cooperative is a strong relationship between farmers and neighbours."


